

GemDuo or Kite bead Mountain Flower Bracelet

ADDENDUM

Use GemDuo beads or Kite beads instead of IrisDuo beads to give your Mountain Flower Bracelet a slightly different look!



MATERIALS

(for a 6.75-inch bracelet, not including the clasp)

GemDuo bead version

- About 7 yards of 6 lb. FireLine
(about 4 feet for each motif; five motifs total)
- About 400 size 11/0 Miyuki (rocaille) seed beads
- About 42 size 3mm beads
(round or fire-polished beads work best)
- 30 StormDuo beads
(7x3mm S-shaped Czech 2-hole beads)
- 30 Matubo GemDuo beads
(8x5mm Diamond shaped Czech 2-hole beads)
- clasp

Kite bead version

- About 7 yards of 6 lb. FireLine
(about 4 feet for each motif; five motifs total)
- About 400 size 11/0 Miyuki (rocaille) seed beads
- About 42 size 3mm beads
(round or fire-polished beads work best)
- 30 StormDuo beads
(7x3mm S-shaped Czech 2-hole beads)
- 30 Czech Kite beads
(9x5mm Kite shaped Czech 2-hole beads)
- clasp

Substitution Instructions

GemDuo bead version (top photo)

Repeat Step 1 to Step 61 but use Czech Gemduo beads instead of IrisDuo beads.

Kite bead version (bottom photo)

Repeat Step 1 to Step 61 but use Czech Kite beads instead of IrisDuo beads.
