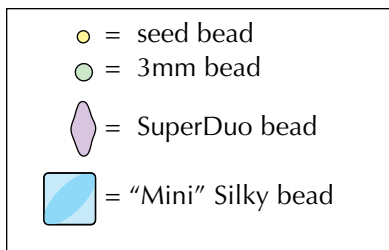


# Mini Silky Squares Bracelet & Earrings



Since this pattern was written in 2015, a new “Mini” 5x5mm Silky bead has been manufactured! My Silky Squares Bracelet & Earrings pattern can be easily adapted for this new Silky bead size with just a few substitutions.



## MATERIALS

### Bracelet

(for a 7-inch bracelet, not including clasp):

- About 4 yards of 6 lb. FireLine
- About 400 size 11/0 seed beads
- About 36 size 3mm beads (can be round beads, fire-polished beads or size 8/0 seed beads)
- About 36 SuperDuo beads
- About 36 two-hole 5x5mm “Mini” Czech Silky beads
- clasp

### Earrings

- About 4 feet of 6 lb. FireLine
- About 100 size 11/0 seed beads
- 8 size 3mm beads (can be round beads, fire-polished beads or size 8/0 seed beads)
- 8 SuperDuo beads
- 8 two-hole 5x5mm “Mini” Czech Silky beads
- two small (2-4mm) jump rings
- a pair of earring findings

## BRACELET

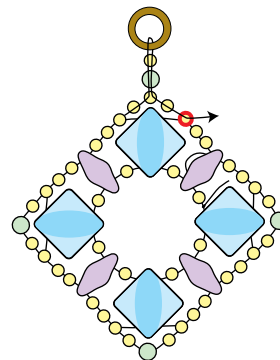
Repeat Step 1 to Step 37 of the Silky Squares Bracelet but make the following substitutions:

- Use “Mini” 5x5mm Silky beads instead of the full-sized 6x6mm Silky beads.
- For Steps 13, 14, 15, 16, 32, 33, 34 and 35, add a seed bead, a 3mm bead and a seed bead instead of adding five seed beads.
- Continue with Step 44 to Step 46 to attach your clasp.

- For Steps 13, 14 and 15, add a seed bead, a 3mm bead and a seed bead instead of adding five seed beads.

• For Step 17 and 18, follow these instructions instead:

**STEP 17-18:** String two seed beads, a 3mm bead and a seed bead. Go around through a jump ring and then back down through the seed bead, the 3mm bead and the seed bead that you just strung. String another seed bead. Go through the seed bead highlighted in **RED**:



## EARRINGS

Repeat Step 1 to Step 16 of the Silky Squares Earring but make the following substitutions:

- Use “Mini” 5x5mm Silky beads instead of the full-sized 6x6mm Silky beads.
